#### PL109 PLANNING APPLICATIONS

11/P/2181/MMA 1 BEACHCLIFFE, BEACH ROAD WEST, PORTISHEAD

Application to vary condition 8 attached to planning permission 09/P/1368/F (erection of detached dwelling) to allow for change to location of dwelling within site

Members recalled the history of the proposed dwelling. It was noted that North Somerset Council's Tree Officer did not consider that the important row of trees to the south of the plot would be further endangered by the amended location of the dwelling.

# SECTION 2 PLANNING MATTERS (RECOMMENDATIONS TO TOWN COUNCIL)

#### PL110 DANGERS OF WALKING/CYCLING ALONG CLAPTON LANE

Members discussed in detail the proposal put forward by a resident of Clapton-in-Gordano for a "safer pedestrian route" for residents to get between Portishead and Clapton-in-Gordano. The proposed route is shown on the letter which is attached to and forms part of these minutes. It was noted that this is not the first time that an alternative pathway has been suggested and that the route is on North Somerset Council's Dormant Rights of Way Improvement Plan.

Whilst the Committee generally supported the need for a safe route they considered that the suggested route starting via the Portisfields Development on Bristol Road would not be used as it was too far out of the way, particularly for Gordano pupils. People will always take the shortest route available.

The Committee suggested that although a path along the inside of the boundary of the school playing fields on Clapton Lane had been looked at in the past, perhaps with Gordano School now being an academy the school could be approached and asked for their views.

#### RECOMMENDATION

Portishead Town Council support the need for a safer pedestrian route from Portishead to Clapton-in-Gordano, however the route should be by the most direct route along Clapton Lane.

The Clerk writes to Gordano School to ask whether, since becoming an Academy, the school has changed their views on a safer pathway being provided from Maysfield, along Clapton Lane, through the school's sports fields.
