### FILMING PROTOCOL

The following Filming Protocol will feature at the top of all Council meeting agendas:

“The proceedings of this meeting may be recorded for broadcasting purposes.

Anyone wishing to film, record, photograph or otherwise report part or all of the proceedings has the legal right to do so unless the press and public are excluded for that part of the meeting.

Anyone filming is asked to remain in the public seating area and film, photograph, or record as unobtrusively as possible from a single fixed position of their choosing. Filming should be conducted without the use of any additional lighting.

Anyone not wishing to be filmed is asked to advise the Chairman before the start of the meeting. The Chairman will inform the meeting, but filming may still continue.

Members of the public may also use Facebook and Twitter or other forms of social media to report on proceedings at this meeting.”
