**North Somerset Council**  
**Town Police Clauses Act 1847 - Section 21**  
**Jubilee event**  
**Closure of Roads In North Somerset**  
**between 2nd June & 5th June 2022**

**Notice is hereby given** that North Somerset Council has made the following order:-

**Order under section 21** of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 for the prevention of obstruction etc.

**Whereas** during certain dates and hours stated in the schedule column 1 to this Order the roads detailed below in the schedule column 2 will be thronged and liable to be obstructed, the North Somerset Council pursuant to the powers conferred by Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 do hereby order and direct that for the purpose of preventing obstruction in the said streets on the said days listed int he schedule the following regulations shall be observed:-

- (1) the roads listed in the schedule to this order shall be closed, as necessary, to all vehicular traffic on the dates and times listed int the schedule to this order
- (2) where possible vehicular access to properties adjacent to the roads affected will be made available for the occupants of those properties.
- (3) clear access into the roads affected by this Order shall be maintained at all times for the passage of Police, Fire Authority, Coastguard and Ambulance Service vehicles in execution of their duties.
- (4) drivers of vehicles requiring access or passage into or through the above named street during the time of the Road Closure as stated above may be diverted along such routes as are considered suitable by Police Officers. During the period of closure, if a diversion is not sign posted then drivers are to find own alternative route via adopted highway. CSAS Accredited Marshals appointed by the event organisers are authorised to divert and direct traffic from and in the above roads as required as are Police Officers, if present. Road Closures will be clearly signed.

The penalty for infringement of the said regulations is a fine not exceeding Level 3 on the Standard Scale referred to in the Criminal Justice Act 1982.

Nothing in this order shall prevent vehicles from proceeding in the said lengths of road when being used in connection with the event stated above.
